- The Caddo Citizen mails from Vivian, La. 70182. The Shreveport Sun mails from Shreveport, La.

- The Caddo Citizen charges 50 cents per issue. Subscriptions to The Caddo Citizen are \$24.00 per year. The Shreveport Sun is 50 cents per issue and subscriptions are \$23.69. Both publications are weekly.

- The publication rate for The Caddo Citizen/Shreveport Sun will remain unchanged at \$3.36 per column inch/24 cents per agate line. There will be no charge for notarized affidavits for all legal notices or display ads placed by the Caddo Parish Commission.

- The Caddo Citizen has and will continue to upload all of the Parish of Caddo's public notices and legals to the internet via the Louisiana Press Association, the state's centralized location for all public notices in Louisiana. This

offers all interested engineers, bidders and others to search a database of public notices from across the state both serving the Caddo Parish Commission and those who are looking for your public notice. The website is www.LouisianaPublicNotices.com.

- The Caddo Citizen will offer (2) complimentary subscriptions for the Parish of Caddo should the Parish of Caddo select The Caddo Citizen/Shreveport Sun as its official legal journal for the fiscal year 2024-2025.
- The Caddo Citizen serves as the official legal journal for the entire region of North Caddo. We serve as the official legal journal for the Caddo Parish Commission, Caddo Parish Fire Districts Seven and Eight, North Caddo Ambulance District, North Caddo Hospital District, the Villages of Mooringsport, Belcher, Gilliam, Ida, Rodessa and Hosston and the Town of Oil. We are the official legal journal for the Town of Vivian. We publish the official tax sale for the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office. All of these are also uploaded to the internet.
- It is our hope that we offer you the lowest bid. But in the event that ours is slightly higher, we ask that you consider our experience in dealing with public notices; our continued support of your community and our working relationship that we have established with the Parish of Caddo. Law does not require you to accept the lowest bid.
- Be advised that the requirements for serving as an Official Legal Journal in the State of Louisiana include that the newspaper be of general interest to the populations; the newspaper have a brick and mortar office in the Parish for which it serves and must have a paid circulation and not a be a free newspaper.
