

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
CADDO PARISH COMMISSION'S
CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE
HELD ON THE 18TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2024

The Caddo Parish Charter Review Committee met in legal session on the above date at 1:00 p.m. in the Government Plaza Chambers Conference Room, with the following members in attendance: Parish Attorney Donna Frazier, Parish Administrator Erica Bryant, Steven Coleman, Mike Johnson, and Dr. Jimmy Jones (5). ABSENT: Versa Clark, Curtis Joseph, Mavice Thigpen, and Commission President John-Paul Young (4)

Mr. Coleman gave the invocation, and Mrs. Bryant led the Committee in the Pledge of Allegiance. There were no Agenda Additions, so the Committee moved onto Public Comments.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Ken Krefft came before the Committee and requested that they push the City to do a Charter Review.

NEW BUSINESS

- *Selection of Officers*

Attorney Frazier asked for volunteers to serve as the officers. Dr. Jimmy Jones volunteered for Chair, and Mr. Mike Johnson volunteer to serve as Vice-Chair. The Clerk of the Commission said that he typically furnishes the minutes for the meetings and still happy to do so.

Attorney Frazier explained that there are five sections of the Charter that they will be discussing. She anticipates that they will be about 5-6 times to discuss those sections.

- *Determination of Meeting Schedule*

Attorney Frazier suggested that the Charter Review Committee not meet on Mondays or Thursdays due to the Commission meetings.


There was a suggestion to meet on Wednesdays. The Committee decided to meet on October 2, October 9, October 23, November 13, and November 20.
