

ORDINANCE NO. 6462 OF 2024 BY

THE CADDO PARISH COMMISSION:

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN MONUMENTS ON PARISH PROPERTY, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Caddo Parish Commission believes that monuments should serve to memorialize persons of notable and great accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, the Caddo Parish Commission believes that such monuments should be free from the stigma of criminality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Caddo Parish Commission in due, legal and regular session convened that the Caddo Parish Commission amends Chapter Two, Article I of the Caddo Parish Code of Ordinances to add the following:

CHAPTER 2-ADMINISTRATION

ARTICLE I.-IN GENERAL

Sec. 2-7.-Prohibition of certain Monuments on Caddo Parish Property

- (a.) There shall be no memorials, monuments, statues, plaques, flags, etc., erected on Caddo Parish Property, or displayed in any buildings owned by the Parish of Caddo, of individuals, organizations, groups, entities that have declared war against the United States of America, or have been found guilty of being traitors against the United States of America.
- (b.) There shall be no memorials, monuments, statues, plaques, flags etc., erected on Caddo Parish Property, or displayed in any buildings owned by the Parish of Caddo, of individuals that have been found guilty of a felony.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance is effective ten days after its final passage.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
