Pen-G 3mL SQ

Carprofen 50mg/ml 2.3mL SQ

Shaved and cleaned wounds

Laceration Repair: closed wounds on medial right hindlimb with 2-0 PDS simple interrupted for subcutaneous layer and dermal layer; closed left forelimb wound with 2-0 PDS simple interrupted for subcutaneous and dermal layer; closed wound lateral right hindlimb with 2-0 PDS simple interrupted for dermal layer

Antisedan 0.45mL IM

Carprofen 100mg - 1/2 tablet by mouth every 12 hours for pain

Clavamox 375mg - 1 tablet by mouth every 12 hours

Client Instructions

Monitor closely for any abnormal behavior or worsening of symptoms: excessive or bloody vomiting, excessive or bloody diarrhea, lethargy, severe pain, loss of appetite for more than 24 hours, neurologic abnormalities, paralysis, etc. If you notice any worsening, new symptoms, or other concerns, recheck as soon as possible with Animal Emergency Clinic or your regular veterinarian.
