

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
CADDO PARISH COMMISSION'S
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMITTEE
HELD ON THE 3RD DAY OF APRIL, 2025

The Caddo Parish Alcoholic Beverage Committee met in legal session on the above date at 1:00 p.m. in the Government Plaza Chambers, with the following members were present constituting a quorum: Commissioners Atkins, Blake, Epperson, Gage-Watts, and Lazarus (5). ABSENT: Commissioners Burrell and Kracman (2).

NEW BUSINESS

- *Consider appeal from Lois Cooper.*

Ms. Cooper is requesting a formal appeal regarding the denial of her application for an alcoholic beverage handling employee card on March 21, 2025, which was denied due to her previous felony parole status, which ended in November 2022, in accordance with Code 1976, 3-25: Code 1985 3-46 (Sec. 4-84) and Code 976, 3-25.1; Code 1985 3-47: Ord. No. 3260, 12-14-1995 (Sec. 4-85).

Attorney Frazier said that this will be tied to the fact. There are certain stipulations in the ordinance for eligibility.

Lt. Maurice Lipman, Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office, explained that due to a revised ordinance, Ms. Cooper is now eligible for an ABO card. Ms. Cooper went through the process again and now has an ABO card.

No action was needed at this time.
