

**RESOLUTION NO. 33 of 2025**

BY THE CADDO PARISH COMMISSION:

A RESOLUTION URGING & REQUESTING THAT THE STATE OF LOUISIANA ALLOCATE APPROPRIATE ATTENTION AND RESOURCES TO REPAIR AND MAINTAIN I-49, I-220, I-20 AND 3132 WITHIN CADDO PARISH.

WHEREAS, the Caddo Parish Commission recognizes the importance of use our voices as elected officials to address matters that are of concern of Caddo Parish citizens; and

WHEREAS, I-49, I-220, I-20 AND 3132 are not only part of the interstate and state systems of transportation, they provide major means of transportation in and around Caddo Parish for parish citizens; and

WHEREAS, many areas of these roads are in dire need of maintenance and repair and in their current state, create transportation obstacles to Caddo Parish citizens; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Caddo Parish Commission in due, regular and legal session convened, that the Caddo Parish Commission does hereby urge and request the State of Louisiana to allocate appropriate attention and resources to repair and maintain I-49, I-220, I-20 and 3132 within Caddo Parish.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be provided to Phillip DeVllier, Speaker of the Louisiana House, J. Cameron Henry, Jr., President of the Louisiana Senate Governor Jeff Landry and the Caddo Parish Legislative Delegation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
