BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Department of Public Works for the Parish of Caddo has received a request from Mr. Jackson Shipp and Mrs. Pamela Shipp to lease 610 Tyre Road. The Parish acquired title to this property under the FEMA Flood Acquisition Program. Mr. and Mrs. Shipp wishes to use this property for gardening and providing a space for their animals. Mr. and Mrs. Shipp fully understand and commit themselves for keeping the property properly maintained and neat in appearance. They also understand that they are restricted from placing any permanent structures or improvements on the property. The property is identified by Caddo Parish Tax Assessor's Geographic Number 161423-000-0039-00.

ORDINANCE NO. 6602 OF 2025

BY THE CADDO PARISH COMMISSION:

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE LEASE OF FLOOD ACQUISITION PROPERTY LOCATED AT 610 TYRE ROAD, SHREVEPORT, CADDO PARISH, LOUISIANA, AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO

WHEREAS, the Parish of Caddo is the owner of certain property situated in Caddo Parish, Louisiana, described as follows:

The West 322.08 feet of the North 165.0 feet of the South 330.0 feet of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 23, Township 16 North, Range 14 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana LESS AND EXCEPT all buildings and improvements located thereon. Muncipial Address: 610 Tyre Road, Shreveport, LA, Geog. Number 161423-0-39.

WHEREAS, the Parish of Caddo purchased the aforesaid properties under the FEMA Flood Acquisition Program, and over three-fourths of them are not usable due to flooding, and they have no real market value; and

WHEREAS, the adjacent landowners have each expressed an interest in leasing the properties for the purpose of providing upkeep and maintaining gardens and animals on said property; and

WHEREAS, the lease of said property prohibits any permanent improvements; however, it sets forth that the entire property will be maintained to present a neat appearance for the neighborhood and prevent any overgrowth; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-11(11) of the Charter of the Parish of Caddo requires the adoption of an ordinance for the conveyance or lease of any lands or property of the parish government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Caddo Parish Commission in due, regular and legal session convened, that the Caddo Parish Commission does hereby authorize the lease of property located at 610 Tyre Road, Shreveport, LA, Caddo Parish, Louisiana to the adjacent land owners, Christopher Shane Rogers, for a period of time as deemed necessary by the Caddo Parish Administrator.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Caddo Parish Administrator or his designee shall be authorized to do any and all things and to sign any and all contracts and other documents in a form acceptable to the Caddo Parish Attorney necessary to effectuate the purposes set forth herein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or applications which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days after publication in the official journal.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
