RESOLUTION NO. 4 of 2026

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HOLDING OF AN ELECTION IN
CADDY PARISH FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER FIVE, STATE OF LOUISIANA,
ON SATURDAY, MAY 16, 2026, TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY OF SERVICE
CHARGES THEREIN.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Caddo Parish Fire District Number Five, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Caddo Parish Fire District Number Five, State of Louisiana (the "District"), adopted a resolution on November 17, 2025, calling a special election in the District on Saturday, May 16, 2026, to authorize the levy of service charges therein; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority of the District has requested that the Caddo Parish Commission, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Caddo, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to levy and collect the service charges provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of the Caddo Parish Commission to approve the holding of said election and in the event that the election carries, to authorize the District to levy and collect the sales and use tax provided for therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Caddo Parish Commission, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Caddo Parish Fire District Number Five, State of Louisiana, the Caddo Parish Commission hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, May 16, 2026, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

**PROPOSITION NO. 1
(SERVICE CHARGE)**

Shall Caddo Parish Fire District Number Five, State of Louisiana (the "District"), levy and collect an annual service charge not to exceed Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) on each residential and commercial structure, whether occupied or unoccupied, located wholly or partly within the District, pursuant to La. R.S. 40:1502.15, excluding that property annexed by the City of Shreveport prior to the election, for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2027 and ending with the year 2036 (an estimated \$100,275 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the service charge for an entire year), for the purpose of fire protection, including emergency medical transportation and all emergency

medical services incidental thereto, acquiring, constructing, maintaining and operating fire protection facilities and equipment in and for the District, including paying the cost of obtaining water for fire protection purposes and salaries of firemen and all purposes incidental thereto?

PROPOSITION NO. 2
(SERVICE CHARGE)

Shall Caddo Parish Fire District Number Five, State of Louisiana (the "District"), levy and collect an annual service charge not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50) on each residential and commercial structure, whether occupied or unoccupied, located wholly or partly within the District, pursuant to La. R.S. 40:1502.15, excluding that property annexed by the City of Shreveport prior to the election, for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2027 and ending with the year 2036 (an estimated \$66,850 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the service charge for an entire year), for the purpose of fire protection, including emergency medical transportation and all emergency medical services incidental thereto, acquiring, constructing, maintaining and operating fire protection facilities and equipment in and for the District, including paying the cost of obtaining water for fire protection purposes and salaries of firemen and all purposes incidental thereto?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, the Caddo Parish Commission does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to levy and collect the service charges provided for therein.
