

RESOLUTION NO. 25 of 2026

BY THE CADDO PARISH COMMISSION:

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING HOUSE BILL 340 OF THE 2026 REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION OF THE LOUISIANA LEGISLATURE RELATING TO TIME OF REAPPRAISAL OF PROPERTY FOR AD VALOREM TAX PURPOSES, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO

WHEREAS, House Bill 340 (2026 Regular Session) addresses the time of reappraisal of property for ad valorem tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 340 increases the reappraisal time from every four years to every five years; and

WHEREAS, increasing the reappraisal time will negatively and directly affect parish revenues and parish revenue projections, particularly where projects have been undertaken based on four-year reappraisal projections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Caddo Parish Commission in due, regular and legal session convened, that the Caddo Parish Commission does hereby express its opposition to House Bill 340 and urges the Louisiana Legislature to reject any legislation that increases the property reappraisal time for ad valorem tax purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Caddo Parish Commission encourages the Legislature to preserve and respect the existing statutory framework of four year reappraisals for ad valorem tax purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent, following adoption, to the Louisiana Legislature and to the members of the legislative delegation of Caddo Parish.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
