

RESOLUTION NO. 41 OF 2026

BY THE CADDO PARISH COMMISSION:

RESOLUTION REQUESTING DATA CENTER OPERATORS TO PRODUCE AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STUDY CONSIDERING THE EFFECTS THAT THEIR DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONS WILL HAVE ON THE RESIDENTS OF DAWSON ROAD INCLUDING THE IMPACT TO EGRESS AND INGRESS, CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS, OPERATIONAL IMPACTS AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO

WHEREAS, Dawson Road area in Caddo Parish has continuously been impacted by flash flooding during heavy rainfalls; and

WHEREAS, this flooding in the area already impedes citizens' ingress and egress to their homes, and limits the ability for emergency vehicles to safely access the area; and

WHEREAS, the data center scheduled to be built in Resilient Technology Park will cause land and vegetation to be cleared in the area, thus removing barriers that affect water flow and potentially causing flooding to worsen in the area; and

WHEREAS, the construction of this data center will also have an impact upon Greenwood Road/Highway 80.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Caddo Parish Commission in due, legal and regular session convened, that the Caddo Parish Commission hereby requests the operators of the data center to be built in Resilient Technology Park to conduct an environmental impact study regarding the construction and operation of its data center and its effects on the citizens of the Dawson Road area, to include the impact to Greenwood Road/Highway 80.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is effective immediately upon its passage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
